I approve of the content of the letter, but I take exception to the target market share for single-family attached projects. My dissenting opinion is below:

As the 2022-2024 conservation and load management plan calls for a transition to residential new construction all-electric incentives, the transition should have started before July 2023, and even accounting for projects that enter the pipeline prior to July 2023, the 2024 market share target of all-electric single-family attached projects should be at least 75%.
